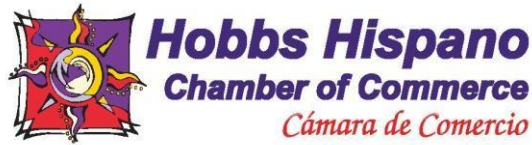

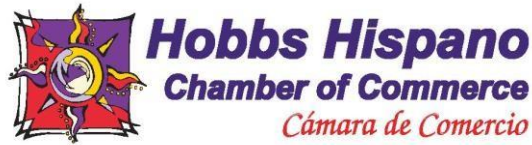

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

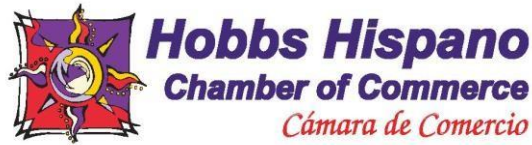

Your business will receive complimentary listing on our Hobbs Hispano Chamber of Commerce website. This includes accessibility to link your business website at no cost for the first year.

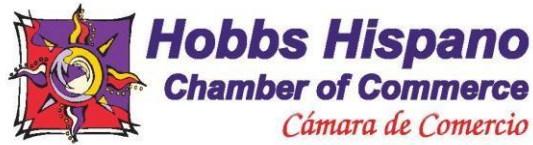
WORKSHOPS AND SEMINARS
